VACANCIES IN THE OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR

There are presently two vacancies on the Town Council following a recent resignation and a previous death, which the Town Council has to fill by co-option.

There is also a third vacancy that is currently being advertised under a 'Notice of Casual Vacancy' before being put out for Co-Option.

A commitment to attend regular monthly meetings and undertake training is required, also some time to support the work of the Town Council within the community.

The Council is inviting interested persons to write in (or email) stating the following:

- Give particular reasons for applying to be a Councillor.
- What practical skills could you offer to the role
- Provide information on your specific interests within the community

The Council is particularly looking for younger people who would like to help shape their community. There is a small remuneration to help with things like babysitting for those with families.

The Council will hold interviews and selection by an application letter. Applicants must ensure that they meet the criteria for qualification to become a Councillor and will be asked to confirm this. A list of these can be obtained from the Clerk or from the Town Council website –
